



## COLÓQUIO INTERNACIONAL “CHINA / MACAU: ROTAS, ESTREITOS MARÍTIMOS E OCEANOS

Mais uma vez o Centro Científico e Cultural de Macau organizou o seu já habitual e muito prestigiado Colóquio Internacional de Outubro, em 2017 subordinado ao tema “China / Macau: Rotas, Estreitos Marítimos e Oceanos Globais”, cuja Comissão Científica foi constituída por Luís Filipe Barreto, Roderich Ptak e Wu Zhiliang.

O Colóquio foi organizado conjuntamente pelo Centro Científico e Cultural de Macau e pela Fundação Macau, com o patrocínio da Fundação Jorge Álvares e o apoio do Casino do Estoril.
